




## Block 44: Lawyer's Puzzle - Betsy Chutchian

Use (1) light and (1) dark fabric. Fabrics are listed in order of use.

- A (2) squares, 3 1/8" x 3 1/8" (LIGHT)
- B (2) squares, 3 1/8" x 3 1/8" (DARK)
- C (12) squares, 1 5%" x 1 5%" (LIGHT)
  - D (12) squares, 1 %" x 1 %" (DARK)
- E (4) squares, 1 ¼" x 1 ¼" (LIGHT)

## Assembly

1. Draw a diagonal line, corner to corner, on the wrong side of (1) A square and place on (1) B square; pin in place. Stitch a ¼" seam allowance on each side of drawn line. Cut in half and press pieced squares toward B. Make (4) Unit #1.







Unit #1's

2. Repeat Step 1 using (1) C square and (1) D square for (2) pieced squares. Make (24).





3. Sew together (3) pieced squares from Step 2, as shown. Make (4) Unit #2. Paying attention to orientation, sew together (3) more pieced squares and add (1) D square. Make (4) Unit #3.













Unit #3

3. Sew Unit #2 to the side of Unit #1, as shown; press toward Unit #2. Sew Unit #3 to the bottom of Unit #1/2; press toward Unit #1. Make (4) pieced units.






4. Sew pieced units together into rows and press rows in opposite direction. Sew rows together (press seam open) to create the Lawyer's Puzzle block measuring 6 ½" square.
