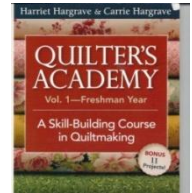
9-A) Freshman Quilters Academy (2 part)

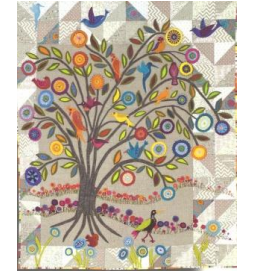
